CRs Take

Our tough tests have found that a brand's flat, eggshell, and semigloss paints perform similarly overall, so we've combined the scores to make it easier for you to compare. The top-rated Behr Marquee interior paint from Home Depot is self-priming and superb at hiding old paint and impressive at resisting stains, but not as smooth as some. The paint withstands scrubbing, but aggressive cleaning will change the sheen. The paint has low levels of volatile organic compounds (VOCs)—some of the noxious chemicals that can make paint smell. VOCs can cause headaches and dizziness, and are linked to pollution, smog, and respiratory problems.

About

The Behr Marquee (Home Depot) is part of the Paint test program at Consumer Reports. In our lab tests, Interior paint models like the Marquee (Home Depot) are rated on multiple criteria listed below.

Hiding: Hiding reflects how well a paint covers dark colors mainly with one-coat.

Staining: Staining shows how well a paint resists tough oil and water based stains.

Gloss change: Gloss change notes the change in appearance when a paint is cleaned aggressively.
