

BEHR® SPRAY PAINT FAQs

How do I spray paint?

- Shake can vigorously for 1-2 minutes after the ball within the can begins to move freely
- Test your spray paint and painting technique on a piece of scrap material
- Hold the spray can 8-12 inches away from project surface
- Spray project using several thin coats of spray paint instead of one thick coat
- Begin and finish your spray pattern off the object, releasing the tip at the end of each pass
- Use an even side-to-side motion
- Overlap your spray pattern with each pass

Can BEHR Spray Paint be used indoors?

- We do not recommend the product to be sprayed indoors due to the need for sufficient ventilation. If you must apply while indoors, then follow these rules:
 - Open all exterior windows and doors to ensure fresh air entry during application and drying
 - Use a fan to circulate the aerosol emissions towards opened windows and doors
 - Wear a painting mask with vapor cartridge for additional respiratory protection

Can BEHR Spray Paint be used as a touch-up paint?

- Spray can touch up over itself after 24 hours to allow the paint to dry.
- Aerosol is NOT used to touch up Behr brush goods of same color (as aerosol colors are not the same sheen or exact match).

Why is the paint sagging or dripping?

- Not letting the paint dry sufficiently between coats
- Coats applied too heavily

The spray tip is clogging.

- Paint is drying on the nozzle
- Turn can upside down and spray until clear (1-2 seconds)
- DO NOT USE PINS IN TIP

How do I remove overspray?

- Paint or lacquer thinner will remove spray paint from the objects surrounding the spray area (test on an inconspicuous area first to ensure compatibility)

How can I tell what color is in the can?

- Cap represents the color in the can better than the graphics on the can label

Is BEHR Spray Paint a paint-and-primer-in-one?

- Primer is not needed over most substrates
- For better protection over metal, Kilz Original or Kilz Odorless aerosol can be used
- Fill in defects with Kilz Original or Kilz Odorless aerosols

Can I use BEHR Spray Paint on plastics?

- Will work over most plastics
- Test small spot for adhesion, appearance first

Can I use BEHR Spray Paint on wood?

- Yes, certainly. May take more coats over wood as it is more porous

When should I recoat?

- Put more coats on EITHER: within the first hour, or after 24 hours
