PREPARATION

- The surface must be clean, free of dust, grease, wax, peeling paint, mold, and mildew. If washing is necessary, use a nonsoapy detergent or a TSP substitute. Rinse well and allow to dry.
- Peeling or Checked Paint: Scrape off loose paint and sand to a smooth surface. Sanding or removal of paint containing lead is hazardous.

• *Glossy Surfaces: For maximum adhesion, scuff sand the surface thoroughly before painting.

 Shake can vigorously for one minute after mixing ball begins to rattle and often during use. Hold can upright, moving from sideto-side while spraying lightly and evenly about 12" from area being painted. Two to three thin coats produce best results.

 Topcoat with BEHR Paint + Primer Clear Aerosol for an added layer of protection.

DRY TIME

- Longer dry time required in cooler temperatures and higher humidity.
- 15 Min Dry Time
- Before 1 Hr or After 24 Hr Recoat Time

CLEAN-UP & DISPOSAL

- Clear spray valve immediately after use by turning can upside down and spraying until only clear gas is released. If spray nozzle becomes clogged, remove and clean.
- Do not stick pins or wire into can opening.
- Clean fresh overspray with mineral spirits or paint thinner.
 Remove dried paint with paint remover, but test small area first to ensure paint remover does not damage substrate.
