

Project Skill Level: Novice DIY'er



Step 1

Using 100-grit sandpaper, lightly sand any raised or rough areas.

TIP: Use a scraper to remove any old caulking or debris from the gap or seam.



Step 2

Using a caulk gun, apply a thin layer of painter's grade caulk to the gap or seam.



Step 3

Immediately following the repair, wipe off any excess caulk with a damp rag or putty knife.



Step 4

Allow the area to dry.

TIP: Reapply caulk where shrinking has occurred.
