

DISPOSAL

WHERE TO USE

*Properly prepared Interior or Exterior surfaces such as: Wood, Drywall, Plaster, Masonry, Metal, Well-bonded Wallpaper, Brick, Stucco, Aluminum and Cinder Block. Do not use on horizontal surfaces.

PREPARATION

(Proper surface preparation is required.) Allow new stucco, plaster and masonry to cure for 30 days. Clean : For interior and exterior surfaces, remove dirt, oil and grease stains with a product such as BEHR PREMIUM® NO. 990 Concrete & Masonry Degreaser & Cleaner. Remove mildew stains with a mildew stain removing product. Remove all loose and peeling paint; scuff sand glossy surfaces; caulk; repair imperfections and sand smooth. For exterior surfaces, powerwash to remove chalk. Etch galvanized metal with a product such as BEHR PREMIUM® NO. 991 Concrete & Masonry Cleaner & Etcher. Follow all label instructions. PRIME: Use a product such as BEHR PREMIUM PLUS® NO. 436 Exterior Multi-Surface Primer & Sealer or product such as BEHR PREMIUM PLUS® NO. 434 Oil-Based Primer & Sealer. Follow all label instructions.

APPLICATION

DO NOT THIN. Stir before and during application. When working with more than one can of the same product, intermix to ensure color uniformity. Use adequate ventilation during application & drying process. Certain colors may require more than one coat to achieve complete hide and coverage. Use product when air and surface temperature are 40-90°F (4-32°C). Apply a thin coat using a high guality china bristle brush, 1/4-3/8" nap roller or an airless sprayer (.013-.015" spray tip).

DRY TIME

Longer dry time required in cooler temperatures and higher humidity. Wait at least 7 days before rinsing or cleaning the surface with a mild, non-abrasive detergent.
